DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE POLICY

Drug Awareness Program

Whereas the use of drugs in the workplace poses grave danger to the staff and residents, the Cortland County Community Action Program, Inc. intends to strictly maintain a drug-free workplace.

Therefore notice is hereby given to all employees that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in any work site of CAPCO. Failure to comply with the provisions of this notice may lead to severe disciplinary action up to and including suspension or discharge.

As a condition of employment with the Cortland County Community Action Program, Inc. the employee will (a) abide by the terms of this statement and (b) notify the employer of any criminal drug statute conviction for violation occurring in the workplace no later than five days after such conviction.
